Where: We've got a really exciting venue for Run4Unity. It's called **THE SCOOP at More London**, an outdoor amphitheatre, and it's just next to the River Thames by City Hall.



The Scoop

And: As London will be hosting the 2012 Olympics, Youth for Unity here want to prepare so that people coming from the five continents will be welcomed into a city which is united and open, where divisions are 'bridged' and everyone is valued and respected.
